Beginning July 1, 2023 all meters will be read every quarter. These readings will be taken in late in the months of March, June, October and December. All water bills will now include overages from the prior 3 months. The first quarterly water bill that will include overage will be the October water bill. The rate structure will be adjusted as follows:
