

## SCHEDULE B

### Rates for New Service installations

Effective March 14<sup>th</sup> 2022

#### New services Installed by the Water District:

- All services must be paid in full prior to work beginning.
- The RCWD does not install water Services in excess of 100 feet. The distance is measured from the property line to the foundation entry point.
- All commercial services regardless of size must be installed by a private contractor according to RCWD rules and regulations.
- Services in excess of 200 feet measured from the property line to the foundation entrance and must have an approved meter pit installed no more than 10 feet from the curb stop.
- Anyone who wishes to do their own Service and Taps must follow the RCWD rules and regulations on tapping water mains.
- Any services that will require flowable fill will be charged at the rate below on per yard basis. The district will estimate the cubic yards needed.
- Any unusual costs will be added to the job estimate

All services installed on a state roadway (Rte. 44) must be done by an approved contractor. All local and state permits required must be obtained by the owner or contractor for any work within the state roadway layout.

Work requiring police details not shown on the new service schedule above will be charged based upon the Raynham Police Departments invoice.

## Rate Schedule C

### Capital Improvement, Demand Charges and Sprinkler connection Fee's

All fees are due before the building permits are signed. On existing buildings all fees must be paid prior to any work beginning on water related work **NO exceptions.**
