The project proponent should review the current rules and regulations of the Raynham Center Water District (RCWD) and as amended. The proponent or their assignee's will be required to adhere to these rules and regulations in perpetuity for both construction and for future water use.

The RCWD supplies water that meets all state and federal laws and guidelines. The RCWD does not guarantee a constant pressure or uninterrupted service. The RCWD also does not guarantee the consumer a particular volume of water or pressure except as required by MA DEP regulations to effectively operate fire sprinkler systems or other appliances, the same being subject to the variable operating conditions that may take place within the water mains of the RCWD.

All new Single-Family units require the submission of an engineered plot plan clearly showing the location of all the proposed utilities including but no limited to water lines, sewer or septic systems, gas lines, drainage lines, underground electric or communication lines. The plot plan must be a minimum of 22 inches by 34 inches. The proposed water line must meet the requirements of the RCWD rules and regulations.

RCWD can run service lines up to 100 ft from the edge of road to the entry point of the home. Pricing is available upon request. For services longer than 100 ft require an approved contractor is required.

Road openings are subject to the Raynham Highway Department moratoriums. Contractors / homeowners are responsible for any road opening permits.

The waterline and meter size are subject to the rules and regulation.

**(OVER)**

Any installation costs and Fee's must be paid in full to the RCWD prior to the installation of the water service.

If the service is installed by a contractor: All Fee's, Capitol Improvement, Demand Charges, inspection fees, meter and shutoff fee's, must be paid prior to the contractor installing the water service.

The RCWD assumes no liability for conditions that exist within a customer's home, commercial, or industrial buildings plumbing system for any damage caused due to the RCWD shutting off water for the purpose of; repairing pipes, meters, hydrants, or any other work done by the RCWD to maintain the integrity of the water system. Consumers are hereby cautioned to maintain their interior plumbing and provide, at their own expense, any and all suitable valves or safety devices necessary to protect their plumbing, appliances or other equipment that may be affected by such incident's. In any event the RCWD expressly stipulates that it will not be held liable for any damage incurred by such circumstances.

This service application shall be good for 36 months from the date all fees have been paid as per the RCWD rules and regulations section 2.1.
